Our school is Lincoln Elementary Montessori located in Norfolk, Nebraska, which is in Northeast Nebraska. The area we examined was close to our school building which has some grassy areas and the rest are all gravel.

We chose to compare our findings with Crosby, Texas, because we thought there would be some similarities and some differences. We are both in the middle part of the US, but Cosby, Texas, is much closer to the equator than Norfolk, Nebraska.

We found many things similar to Crosby, Texas, and a few different.
